

FWA DJ Livestock Higher as Cutout Prices Rise -- Market Talk

1501 ET - Livestock futures on the CME finished higher, with live cattle futures up 0.5% and lean hog futures up 0.1%. For both, higher cutout prices were a factor supporting futures. The USDA today reported that boxed beef prices rose \$1.96 per hundredweight, to \$196.11 per cwt. Meanwhile, pork carcass cutouts rose midday by 68 cents per cwt, to \$81.60 per cwt. Domestic and export demand has been issues pressuring livestock futures, particularly hog futures. (kirk.maltais@wsj.com; @kirkmaltais)
